New Learning	What you will be learning about this week	Up until Christmas we are completing a large piece of coursework (20-23 hours) which is an external task set by the examboard. Currently the hand in date for this is Christmas to be submitted to the examboard by Jan 10 th 2020. The examboard have applied to ofqual to extend the project to allow it to be submitted in the summer series also, as under the usual rules they would release a new assignment in January. This would allow schools some contingency to complete the work in light of students having been unable to access the work whilst self isolating.
